

Hui Whakarewa



The hui whakarewa is a 3-day professional development hui which takes place on either a local marae, or the school marae. The hui whakarewa begins with a powhiri and whakawhanaungatanga on the first day. During the hui whakarewa teachers are led through GEPRISP and co-operative teaching practices are modelled throughout the three days.
