Employment, Training and NCEA

Barista Course with NZQA Certificate



Barista industry training with a qualification for coffee enthusiasts or trainee Barista's. We are offering a certificate of achievement in Barista Skills. This is a six week course totalling 12 hours of espresso coffee making and theory. You will cover the following unit standards:

17284 - Demonstrate knowledge of coffee origin and production 17288 - Prepare and present espresso beverages for service

This qualification is the minimum industry requirement for a trained Barista. The cost is \$250 and includes the workbook, certificate and materials.
