### **Kaupapa**

The Effective Teaching Profile was developed from Maori student's narratives of experience with support from narratives of their whanau, principals and teachers. The Effective Teaching Profile provides direction and focus for the professional development undertaken in Te Kotahitanga. In the narratives of experience, students articulated clearly the issues relating to them as Maori students, which they saw in relation to teaching practice in the classroom.

### **The Effective Teaching Profile (ETP)**

Culturally appropriate and responsive teachers demonstrate the following understandings: They positively reject deficit theorizing. They are committed to and know how to bring about change in the educational achievement of students in the following ways:

Manaakitanga	They care for students as culturally located human beings
Mana motuhake	They care for the performance of students
Whakapiringatanga	They create a secure, well-managed learning environment
Wananga	They can engage in effective teaching interactions
Ako	They can use a range of teaching strategies to promote change
Kotahitanga	They promote and monitor outcomes for students
