## **MASSEY HIGH SCHOOL GATEWAY PROGRAMME**



### **What is Gateway?**

#### **GATEWAY is funded by TEC (Tertiary Education Commission)**

GATEWAY students are senior students (Year 12 and 13) who attend a work placement one day a week for around 6 to 10 weeks and also gain extra credits towards NCEA. Students apply to be a GATEWAY student in the previous year and there is a selection process followed which includes an interview with the Massey High School GATEWAY staff.

#### **A suitable GATEWAY candidate will have the following attributes:**

- ✓ A good attendance record.
- ✓ Have a good work ethic at school (and in part-time job, if applicable)
- ✓ Able to identify a future career path.
- ✓ Have a proven academic record (achieved the minimum level of credits in NCEA English/Maths, Level 1 or 2). Able to catch up on missed school work.
- ✓ Excellent behaviour, honest and trustworthy.
- ✓ Positive attitude, mature and willing to learn.
- ✓ Commitment.
- ✓ New Zealand Citizen or Resident.
- ✓ 16 or turning 16 during the year (must be 16 to attend Gateway placement).

#### **Benefits to the GATEWAY student include:**

- ✓ Gain valuable work experience.
- ✓ Gain unit standards relating to their career interest and Health and Safety in the workplace.
- ✓ Increased self-confidence.
- ✓ Develop an awareness of expectations in the work place.
- ✓ Improve motivation and communication skills.
- ✓ Units of work and essential equipment for the placement are paid for by the Gateway Programme.
