

Entry Routines

All students are greeted on entry, enter the teaching space in an orderly and efficient fashion. This is also an opportunity to check gauge mood, ask how they are, and address any concerns quietly.

- Smile
- Juniors lined up outside the room, where physically possible
- Personal greeting
- Uniform and equipment check on entry
- Instructions given as students enter or before they enter the space
- Presentation always on screen with title, date and do now instruction
- If there is no space to line up, class enters and prepares quickly for the lesson. Late comers remain outside so that they do not interrupt instructions – then come in
- Competition with the class to see if I can beat them to the room
- Ensure all phones are put away before they enter the room
- Post on Teams any changes to room or information needed for the lesson to start promptly
- Students enter and stand in circle ready for instructions
- Change into gear and sit in circle ready to begin
- Follow up any student with incorrect uniform or equipment once the rest of the class is inside
- Music playing – links to the lesson but is also a reminder to be in and ready before it finishes
- Teacher should be there on time
- Check in with each student as they enter the room
- Give 1 or 2 simple verbal instructions as they enter
