

Cooperative Learning Strategy: Jigsaw groups

Students are divided into small groups; each group learns a portion of content, and then, after the teacher reassigns students to other groups, each student explains to their new group what they have learned. <https://www.jigsaw.org/>. Checklist for this activity:

Students know:	✓
What group they will be in for the first activity.	
What group they will be in for the second activity.	
How they are to work together to learn and summarise what they are learning.	
The product they need to create to share with the second group.	
That the teacher has given the stamp of approval to the first task before moving to the second group.	
How they should communicate with each other in both groups: listening and talking.	
How they will record what they learn from their second group.
