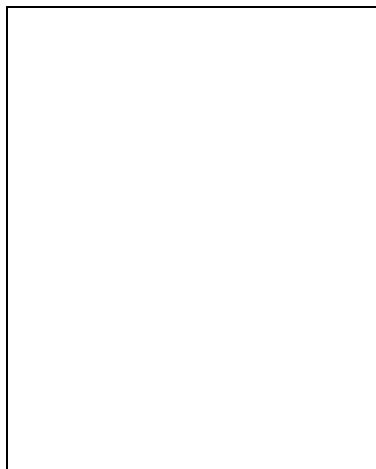

If you accept the offer of a place then this application for tuition and the attached tuition agreement shall be the terms and conditions of agreement by which tuition shall be provided to the student. The terms must be signed by a parent or guardian if the student is under the age of 20 years. The parent or guardian shall be bound by these terms and conditions. If the student is aged 20 years or over then the duties, obligations and authorisations of the parents of the student set out in these terms and conditions shall attach to the student, and all references to "Parents" shall be read accordingly.

CODE:

“Massey High School Board of Trustees has agreed to observe and be bound by the Code of Practice for the Pastoral Care of International Students published by the Minister of Education. Copies of the Code are available on request from this institution or from the New Zealand Ministry of Education website at <http://www.minedu.govt.nz>”

HEALTH AND TRAVEL INSURANCE:

“Most students are not entitled to publicly funded health services while in New Zealand unless they are:-

- A resident or citizen of Australia; or
- A national of the United Kingdom in New Zealand; or
- The holder of a temporary permit that is valid for two years or more

If you do not belong to one of these special categories and you receive medical treatment during your visit, you will be liable for the full costs of that treatment. Therefore, all fee-paying students are to have insurance that will cover the cost of medical treatment in New Zealand for the duration of your stay in New Zealand. Fee-paying students are also required to obtain insurance to cover travel to and from New Zealand.”

IMMIGRATION:

Full details of visa and permit requirements, advice on rights to employment in New Zealand while studying, and reporting requirements are available through the New Zealand Immigration Service, and can be viewed on their website at <http://www.immigration.govt.nz> .”

All contracts will be subject to New Zealand Law. New Zealand Law will apply and that the parties submit to the jurisdiction of the New Zealand Courts
